

DALBY BRIDGE CLUB INC COVID-SAFE PLAN

Eligibility to Play

Eligibility to play will be limited to financial members of the Dalby Bridge Club Inc., and visitors who are registered financial members of ABF.

If a player has been diagnosed with Covid or is classed as a close contact (ie has spent > 4 hours with a person subsequently diagnosed with Covid, during their potentially infectious period), that player should notify both their playing partner and the Director of this scenario. It is suggested that the playing partner carry out a RAT test, kits being available at chemists.

Procedure on Arrival and at Tea Breaks

Wearing of masks by players in the clubhouse is at their own discretion.

Hands should be sanitised on entry. On arrival, while waiting for play to commence, try to maintain social distancing.

Morning tea/supper breaks are when there is the greatest likelihood of players congregating together in close proximity. Where possible, players should use a sit out game or a dummy hand to collect their beverage, thereby reducing the buildup around the serving area at the break. Try to avoid crowding while using the urn, and water fountain.

Procedures at the Playing Table

At the playing table, there will be two bottles of alcohol based liquid sanitiser. Hands should be sanitised as needed, especially after handling money and food. All players should ensure they cover their mouth and/or nose if they sneeze or cough, and should subsequently sanitise their hands.

End of Play

Chairs should be left out from the table to make vacuuming of the room by the contract cleaner easier. E/W will be responsible for emptying bins. The cleaning of playing tables, side tables and chairs using spray bottles containing a recommended cleansing agent, and wipes will be carried out by the contract cleaner after Friday's session. However, it needs to be completed by players after Wednesday night and Thursday supervised play sessions. The same applies to the cleaning of miscellaneous items such as toilet fixtures, door knobs and light switches at the end of the session.
